COMMENT The fill is similar to that of 6114 but the concentration of burnt limestone is not so high.

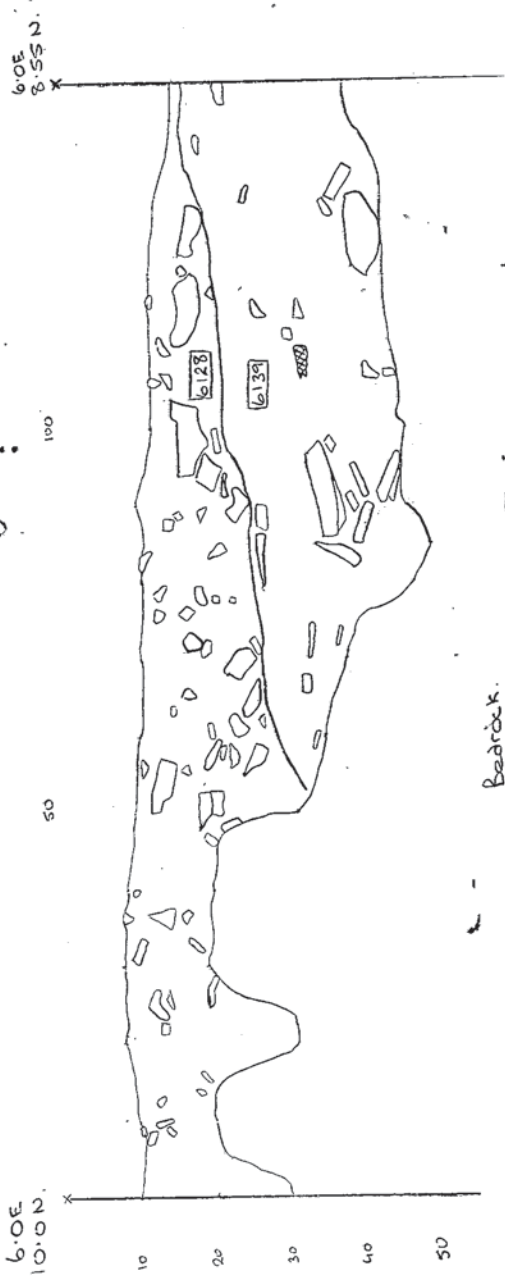
