COMMENT

6136 is cut by 6114. The finds from 6136 then appear to have been redeposited in 6114 (eg the large bones - which in 6114 have usually been broken).
6136 is later than both camouflaged ditches (5299, 6126) and appears to be symmetrical to 6205 but the concentration of finds is not as high as that in 6205.

6136. is later than the fence line associated with entrance of the first runway ditch (6120) as it overlies the stake holes. The stake holes have a fill of orange soil whereas 6136 is red/brown.
