ASSOCIATED FINDS

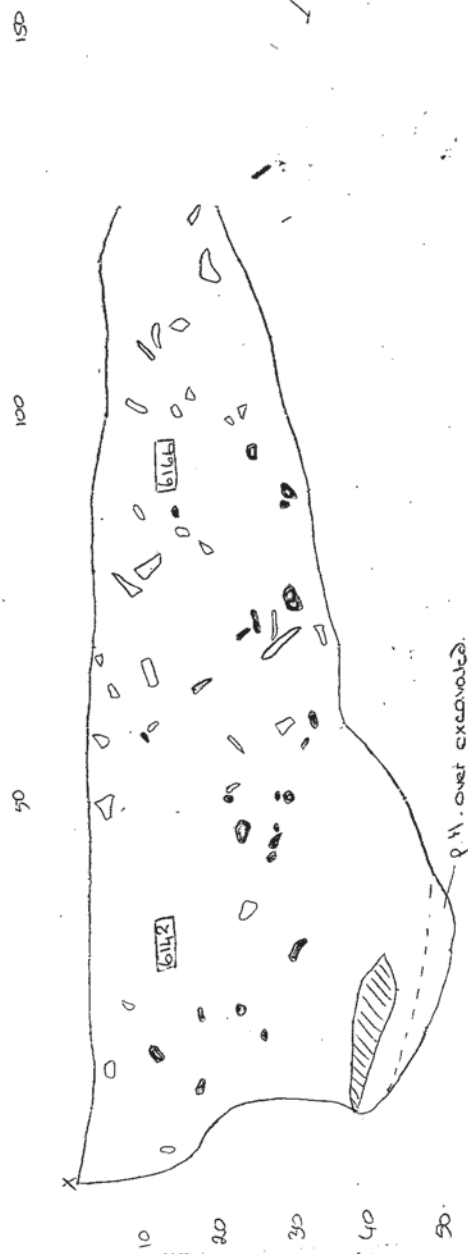
COMMENT 6141, 6166, 6195, 6163, 6165, 6167, 5872 6142, 6143 + 5872 (6143) appear to form the southern side of an entrance relating to ditch 6120. These features predate ditch 5799 which cuts 6120. The other side of the entrance is made up of fence lines (6173, 6174, 6175) (See 6501) running in an easterly direction.

The fill (soil and stone) is very burnt. The soil is dark purple in colour

Flap is a post hole and Flap appears to be a trench dug in order to remove the post. The eastern edge to the posthole was clear but the western edge (where the trench had cut into it) was not clear in excavation or section.
