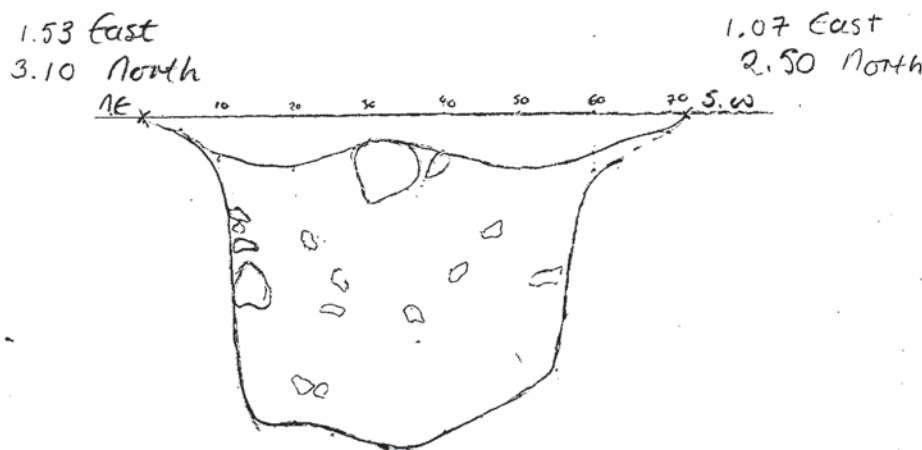
COMMENT PH of a granary.

After the removal of turf a circular area of brown soil (F6558) was noted. Upon excavation this feature seemed to be just a soil filled hollow. Overlay 1 to plan 1 then shows this area (ie the above co-ordinates) as an area of chippie in a layer containing larger stones. Thus it may be noted that this feature (ie F2029) was visible after the removal turf and topsoil and must therefore be of a later date, ~~probably~~ Iron Age PHASING or later.
